Resumo

Currently, the consumption of legal and illicit drugs has increased worldwide. According to the World Health Organization (WHO), drug use is considered a public health problem. Factors such as socioeconomic status, social and family relationships, education level and the environment in which the individual lives need to be taken into consideration. Drug use not only affects social and family life, but also the individual's general health, including oral health.
